Sub: Exemption of Govt. owned Departmental Irrigation Tube wells in case of Re-Drilling.

In reference to the above subject, you are hereby informed that the 'Govt. owned departmental irrigation Tube wells' are exempted from the purview of obtaining Permits in case of 'Re-drilling' proposals for existing wells, as those have already been taken into consideration in the 6th M.I Census (2017-2018). In case of any change in the location, depth and specifications of irrigation Tube Well including the pumping device in place of existing Tube wells installed before 2018 and also, for the Tube Wells installed after 2018, a fresh Permit from SWID has to be sought. Also, the guidelines for exemption of Permit vide G.O. No. 189 dt. 03.11.2011 of WRI&DD is to be followed. This topic will be placed to frame a specific policy guideline in the forthcoming State Level Authority.

NOTIFICATION

Whereas, the issue regarding low incidence of electrified in gattom pumps has been the concern in the State Government. One of main reason assigned to this was that Power utilities were not extending power connection to the farmers for energizing pumps without the permit received under West Bengal Ground Water Resources (Management, Control and Regulation) Act- 2005.

Whereas, the Stage of Development of the Dynamic Ground Water Resources has been about forty percent for the State as a whole and only 38 Blocks have been identified where Stage of Development is either Semi-critical or Critical.

Hence, in exercise of powers under section 7 of the West Bengal Ground Water Resources (Management, Control and Regulation) Act- 2005, I have been directed by the order of the Governor, that all wells outside the Critical and Semi-Critical Blocks, which meet any of the following technical criterions, henceforth, be exempted from the purview of the above mentioned Act.

Crimition for Exemption

- 1. Wells up to a depth of the centrifugal limit, and proposed to be fitted with electromotor pump, set with maximum discharge of 30 Cubic meters per hour.
- 2. Wells proposed beyond the centrifugal limit, fitted with electromotor pump set with discharge not exceeding 30 cubic meters per hour.
- 3. All wells litted with electromotor pump set of S.C HP or less.

This shall take immediate effect.
